### RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### **General**

1. The Amazing Youth Race 2008 will be held on the 21<sup>st</sup> of June 2008, and will be governed by the organising committee. The committee has complete discretion in formulating and applying all rules and penalties. These rules may be modified or altered at the discretion of the organising committee at any time.
2. All competitors are responsible for reading and understanding the rules and regulations and any verbal instructions given before and during the race.
3. A pre-race briefing will be held on Race Day at NTUC Centre, No1, Marina Boulevard at 8am, 21<sup>st</sup> June 2008. Participants will be brief in detail of the Race's Rules & Regulations.
4. The results for the race will be determined by the time taken to complete the course plus penalties, if any. The official Race Clock will run continuously starting with the gun/horn signifying the start, and stopping (for each team) when the last member crosses the finish line.
5. All teams are required to report at the End Point by 4pm on event day with the Team Passport, failure which the teams will be subjected to time penalty.
6. The organising committee, their sponsors and appointed staff and officials will not be held responsible for the cancellation of event due to unforeseen circumstances.
7. Cheating is strictly prohibited. Teams caught cheating will be disqualified.
8. Team members are required to remain as one team together throughout the race (within 50m).
9. Please do not litter, cause damage to public property, or be a public nuisance.

#### **Race Participants**

1. Teams must notify the respective Union's event IC of any substitution of team via email or phone. The organizing committee reserves the right to reject any substitution of team members from those stated on the registration form submitted by the team and to disqualify teams with unregistered members.
2. Registration is based on a first-come-first-serve basis, with 10 teams allocated per Union.
3. It is the responsibility of each individual to be punctual on the event day. Latecomers will not be entertained. The team will be disqualified if one or more of the team member is late.
4. The organizing committee, their sponsors, appointed staff and officials will not be held responsible for damages resulting from injury, whichever fatal or otherwise, or for damages or loss of personal property while participating in the event.

#### **Branding**

Participants will be provided with an event t-shirt upon registration on event day, which they are required to wear throughout the event day.
